Job Posting: Advocate Supervisor

Program Description: Chesterfield CASA, the Court Appointed Special Advocates program, is a nonprofit organization that trains volunteers to advocate for abused and neglected children involved in the juvenile court system in Chesterfield-Colonial Heights. The CASA concept is based on the commitment that every child has the right to a safe, permanent home. Our 70 CASA volunteers provide juvenile judges with a carefully researched background investigation of the child to help the Court make the best decisions about the child's future. Position Description: We are seeking an Advocate Supervisor to supervise, support, and monitor volunteer child advocates. The staff will assist with court report writing and accompany volunteers to court hearings, as well as collaborate with professionals within the community while advocating for child victims.

Qualifications: Candidates for the position should have a Bachelor's degree in Social Work (or related field) or equivalent experience. Knowledge and experience in child welfare practice is required. The candidate must possess excellent writing and organizational skills. Experience in volunteer management is preferred. EOE
